The Oxford University Alumni Society of Greece has been operating unofficially for a number of years. In September 2006, its constitution was drafted and approved by founding members paving the way for a formal establishment in February 2007.

The Society encourages close relations between its members and the collegiate University, and supports a world-wide network of over 160 volunteer-run branches, one of the most extensive alumni networks in the world. At the invitation of the Society, University academics have spoken at branches as far away as Beijing and as close as London. It has links with college alumni groups and with University special interest and subject-based groups.

The Society runs the Email Forwarding Service for graduates and the Oxford Alumni Card scheme. A varied world-wide Travel programme, offering Oxonians the opportunity to travel to a host of fascinating destinations, is available to all members. In addition the Society promotes a variety of one-day events and an annual reunion each summer.
